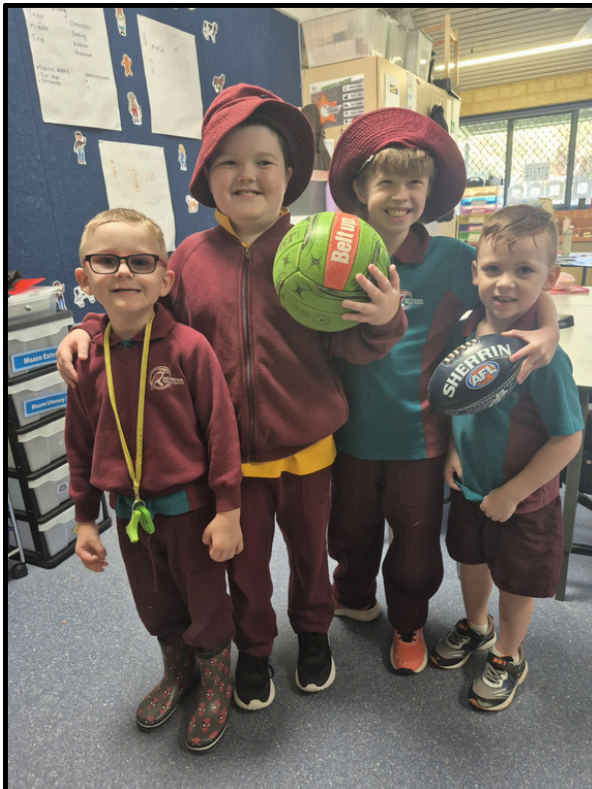
On Saturday May 9th, it was the Quinns Mindarie SLSC Annual Awards Dinner.
