The program aims to provide an opportunity for children with disabilities to enjoy the benefits of baseball and participation in a team sport, in an environment structured to their abilities.

Game Play
All players bat and field in every inning, no one sits off. Each player has a buddy that supports them throughout the game, with batting and fielding. No scores are kept, players receive balls tossed by a coach or hit off a tee when batting. There are no outs, and every player moves around the bases.

Games are played at Wanneroo Giants Baseball Club, Kingsway Sporting Complex, Madeley on Saturday mornings 8:30am - 9:30am. The season runs from October to March, with a break over the summer school holidays.
