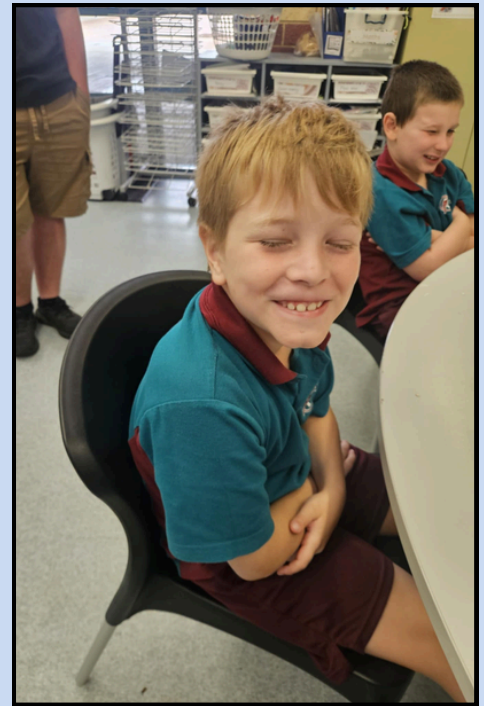
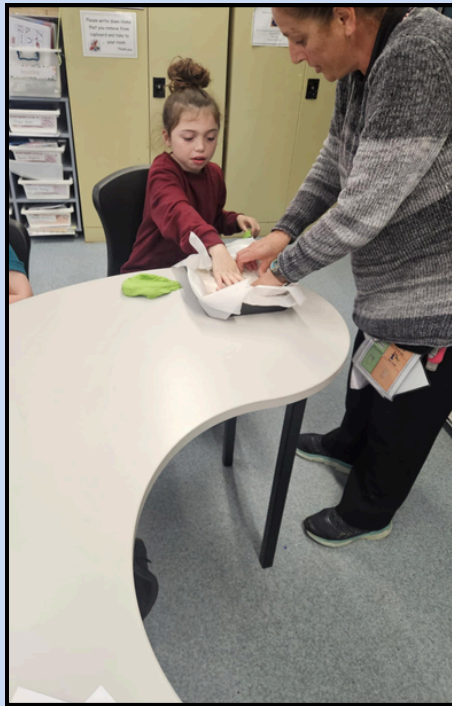

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Room 27



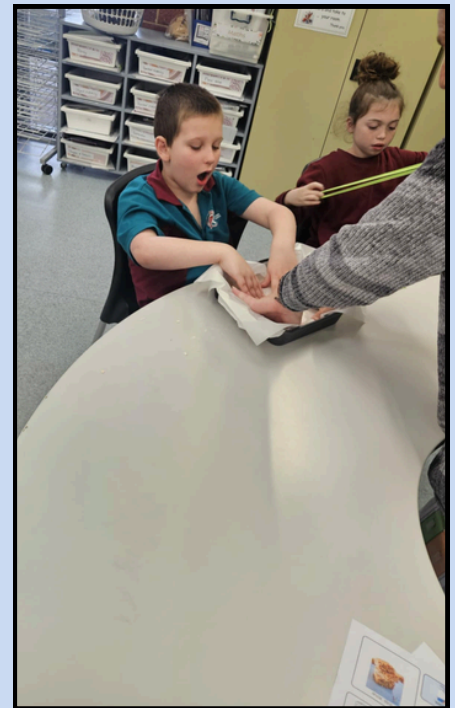
Rooms 27 and 35 have been collaborating in STEM learning, exploring a variety of topics in biological sciences. From observing plant growth to conducting simple experiments, students have been engaged in investigating the world around them through hands-on, inquiry-based learning.

These sessions have sparked curiosity, supported problem-solving, and encouraged meaningful collaboration between peers across classrooms.
