Our programs are crafted to inspire joy, foster independence, and equip participants with valuable skills that extend well beyond the holidays, supporting their growth throughout the entire school year.

Program Schedule

- **Summer Holidays:** Mid-December to early February
- **Autumn Holidays:** Following the first school term, typically in April
- **Winter Holidays:** Mid-year break, usually in July
- **Spring Holidays:** Late September to early/mid-October

Each holiday program runs Monday to Friday, providing a structured and supportive environment for young NDIS participants to stay active, engaged, and socially connected.
