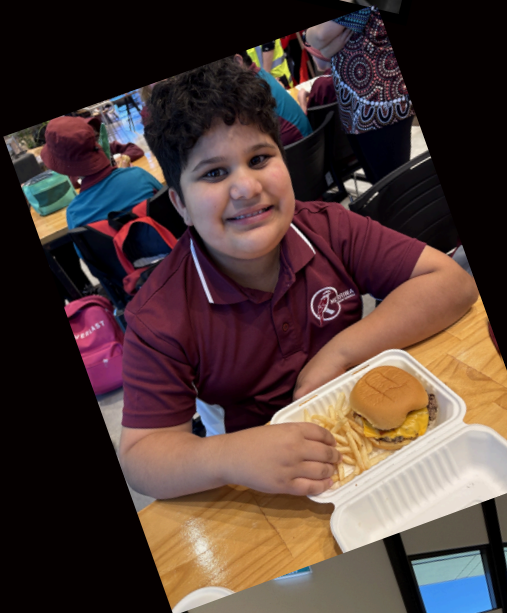


Room 34 celebrated World Bee Day on Tuesday by making bee themed hats and dancing the Waggle Dance!

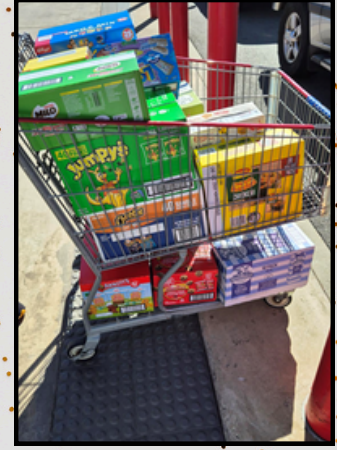
A Heartfelt Thank You to Storm and Family
